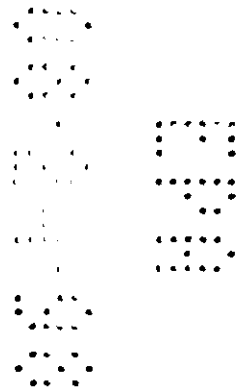

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**USE ONLY IN WELL VENTILATED AREA  
HOLD BOTTLE IN UPRIGHT POSITION WHEN SPRAYING**

Cover animal's eyes with hand. With a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. Spray fingertips and rub on face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub your hand against the lay of the hair spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wet ticks. Do not reapply product for 4 to 7 days. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

**PETS SLEEPING QUARTERS**

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. Pet's bedding should be treated, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed. After spray has dried remove old bedding and replace with clean bedding. Treat pets as directed above [with one of our flea and tick control products registered for use on pets] before allowing them to enter treated area.

**Storage and Disposal**

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.

**Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals**

**WARNING: Humans:** Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. If person is unconscious do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
