It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover animal's eyes with hand. With a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. Spray fingertips and rub on face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub your hand against the lay of the hair spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Thoroughly wet ticks. Do not reapply product for 4 to 7 days. . Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, , aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, lightly spray into the air. Repeat as needed. Spray Pet's bedding , making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed. After spray has dried remove old bedding and replace with clean bedding. Treat pets as directed above before allowing them to enter treated area.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame.
If Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-Cleanup for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
