**DIRECTIONS:** Shake well before using as some settling may occur during shipment. Sprinkle powder evenly and lightly over carpet and adjacent floors by shaking container from side to side. Wait 30 minutes then vacuum. If ticks are present leave powder on surface for two hours before vacuuming. Sprinkle Treat only surfaces over areas that can be vacuumed. If ticks are present leave powder on surface for two hours. Do not Avoid use on wet spots. If product adheres to a wet spot, rub with a stiff brush, allow to dry, then and vacuum.

**Storage and Disposal**

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** If Empty: Do not reuse this container.
