DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product kills ants, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, fleas, houseflies, mosquitoes, rice weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, small flying moths, sow bugs, spiders and ticks.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors in area to be treated. Turn off fans and air conditioners. . Close doors and windows. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area . Do not remain in the area during treatment and thoroughly ventilate before reentry. Vacuum all carpeted areas 24 hours after treatment.

Do not use more than one fogger per room. Do not use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off all ignition sources, such as pilot lights (shut off gas vales), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

To operate valve: Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table or the floor in the center of the room. Be sure to cover entire surface of stand or table to prevent damage. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. For automatic discharge, lock valve in open position by pressing the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. To air out, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying. Repeat
Food areas include areas for receiving, storage, packaging (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas are places where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but not excluding areas where foods are prepared or held. Non-food areas include entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present.

Foggers alone will not control fleas and ticks. To control fleas and ticks, simultaneously treat the pet and its inside and outside living areas. [To effectively control fleas and ticks, simultaneously treat your pet, home and yard.] If you treat only your home (or you're your pet) the treatment will not be effective and the fleas and ticks will return. In addition, the fogger mist may not reach underneath large pieces of furniture (such as beds, sofas, etc.). Treat these areas with a direct spray product registered for flea and tick control in these areas.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame or other sources of ignition. **Disposal:** Do not puncture or incinerate! If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-Cleanup for disposal instructions.

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals
