**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE OPENING**

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Do not treat pets with this product. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

**PREPARATION:** Cover aquariums and remove all pets. Remove children's and pet's toys from area to be treated, including closet floors, and under tables and beds. Cover TV's, VCR's and Computer equipment, etc., to protect from dust.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR FLEA CONTROL**

**CARPETS:** Treat one room at a time. Vacuum all carpeted areas thoroughly and dispose of vacuum bag. Use caution during application as powder will flow freely. Apply to dry surfaces only, at the rate of one pound per 300 square feet. Apply evenly on all carpeted areas, including closet floors, under furniture, and where pets frequently traffic or sleep. Work powder deeply into fibers and mat with a broom or rug rake. Any visible powder after application must be brushed into carpet fibers, removed or vacuumed.

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**ALLOW THREE TO FIVE WEEKS FOR MAXIMUM FLEA CONTROL**

**NOTE:** If a high adult flea population exists in the home, you may want to apply a pesticide (or an insert name of a product registered for adult flea control) registered to kill adult fleas before using this product.

**UPHOLSTERY:** Remove loose cushions of upholstered furniture. Clean and vacuum furniture wells thoroughly. Apply powder along creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply product to exposed fabric. Work powder deep into wells and the surrounding fabric until it disappears. Any visible powder after application must be removed by vacuuming before replacing cushions. Reapply as necessary.

(DIRECTIONS FOR ADDITIONAL USES)

**KILLS ROACHES, ANTS & SILVERFISH**

Easy to use, odorless powder's residual action continues for as long as powder is kept dry and left undisturbed.

**To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish,** apply liberally, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into openings and around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits; and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells.

Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

**Directions for Applying in New Construction to Control Cockroaches:** When treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction, dust liberally using dusting application equipment.

**Directions for Applying as a Mop Solution to Control Cockroaches:** Add 8 ounces of powder to each gallon of rinse water. Apply to floor areas only. Make only enough for each application. Supplemental treatment only.

**Directions for Applying in Sewers to Control Cockroaches:** Apply 16 ounces of product in sewer using dusting application equipment.

This product may be used in homes, restaurants, and other food and feed handling establishments, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery store, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theaters, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

**CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT**

**Food and Feed Handling Establishments:** Places other than private residences in which exposed food or feed is held, processed, prepared or served.

**FOOD AREA-APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY**

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems such as mills, dairies, bakeries, restaurants or anywhere food or feed is stored, processed, prepared or served. Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area.

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Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed food and feed processing, preparation and serving surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or feed processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AND FEED AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT, ARE NOT PERMITTED.

**Serving Area Facilities:** places where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction, into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

**NON-FOOD AREAS:** includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Wrap and put in trash.

**CAUTION**

**FIRST AID**
