DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO OPERATE: SHAKE BEFORE USING. Hold pump sprayer 18 to 24 inches from foliage or surfaces being treated. Direct the spray so that upper and lower surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. This insecticide may be used indoors, outdoors or in greenhouses throughout the growing season, or as a pre harvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations. To control insects named, apply this spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment every seven days, or more frequently under heavy insect pressure, to control infestations. May be applied on day of harvest.

Use on the following ornamentals: African Violets, Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Dogwood, Geraniums, Gladoli, Marigolds, Roses and Wandering Jew. **To control:** Aphids, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers and Whiteflies. **To kill on contact:** Gypsy Moth Caterpillars and adults, adult Japanese Beetles and Eastern and Forest Tent Caterpillars.

On Roses and in Flower Gardens: Treat plants and flowers as soon as insects appear. Spray plants and flowers, making sure to penetrate dense foliage.

On Trees and Shrubs: Treat trees and shrubs as soon as insects emerge (usually late spring). Treat leaves, branches and tree trunks evenly, making sure to penetrate dense foliage.

Use on the following crops: Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Celery, Collards, Cranberries, Eggplant, Kale, Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach, Tomatoes and Turnips. **To Control:** Aphids, Asparagus Beetles, Blister Beetles, Cabbage Loopers, Colorado Potato Beetles, Cross-Striped Cabbageworms, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Fireworms, Flea Beetles, Green Peach Aphids, Harlequin Bugs, Imported Cabbageworms, Leafhoppers, Leaf-tiers, Mexican Bean Beetles, Stink Bugs, 12-Spotted Cucumber Beetles, Webworms and Whiteflies.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Contact a physician or poison control center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth nor induce vomiting if person is unconscious or convulsing. **If on Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If in Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if warranted.
