Dear Ms. Hawkes:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Under the "Precautionary Statements" section, revise the third sentence to read "Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist."
2. Under "For Outdoor Pests", correct the spelling of the word "per."
3. Either delete the phrases "Repeat as necessary" or "Repeat as needed" or "Repeat applications as needed" or indicate a time period for retreatment based on the residual efficacy of your product.

The label says "Cut along the dotted line and remove water soluble packet". Is the water soluble packet to be dropped into the sprayer? If so no directions are given to do this. What is the concentration of esfenvalerate in the packet?

### Sprayer Instructions

How to prime and care for your sprayer:

1. After shaking product well, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.
2. Turn sprayer nozzle one-half turn counter-clockwise. [Turn sprayer nozzle until fully open.] Hold sprayer below the level of container and prime by pumping trigger 10-15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to find spray or jet stream as needed.
3. To store, turn nozzle to 'OFF' position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.

### For Indoor Pests

Apply as a coarse, wet spray to thoroughly treat hiding places, such as cracks and crevices, moist areas around pipes, under refrigerators, along baseboards or other areas where insects may frequent or hide. Spray directly on insects when possible. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until the spray has dried. Repeat as necessary. In the home, cover all food

processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Centipedes, Crickets, Millipedes, Psocids, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Waterbugs:** Apply this spray with a sprayer that produces coarse, wetting droplets into all cracks and crevices in woodwork, floors, underneath sinks, areas behind pipes, pieces of equipment or areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards; around door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, cabinets, around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Contact as many insects as possible with direct spray. Pests driven out of hiding places should be directly sprayed. For ants, apply to ant trails around doors and windows and wherever these pests may find entrance. Repeat applications as needed.

**To Kill Carpenter Ants:** Apply as a coarse spray around doors, door frames, windows and other areas where ants enter premises or hide. Spray into cracks and crevices, through openings or small, newly drilled holes into wall voids where ants or their nests are present.

**For Outdoor Pests**

**General:** Use this product to control on contact: **cockroaches, ants, crickets, sowbugs, spiders and ticks.** Use at the rate of 1 gallon per 500 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests are seen or found. Due to possible injury, do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs.

**Building Perimeter Treatment:** To help prevent infestations of buildings by **ants, boxelder bugs, centipedes, crickets, hornets, millipedes, scorpions, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders, wasps and yellow jackets,** treat a 2-6 foot band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings, building foundations to a height of 2-3 feet, eaves, crawl spaces or other areas where these pests are active and may find entrance. Apply as a coarse, wet spray at the rate of 1 gallon per 500 square feet. Repeat as needed. Keep children and pets off treated areas for 24 hours or until the grass has completely dried.

**Storage and Disposal**

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to of children and pets. Protect from freezing. If Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-Cleanup for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
