This amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. We do not object to referencing other Enforcer products to control fleas at other sites, however the phrase "for complete flea control xxx" is misleading in that it implies less than adequate control from use of the subject product alone and 100% control if all these products are used. We recommend revising the statement to identify other flea control products at other sites i.e., "For additional control of fleas in and around the home use Enforcer Flea Spray for Yard xxx etc."

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

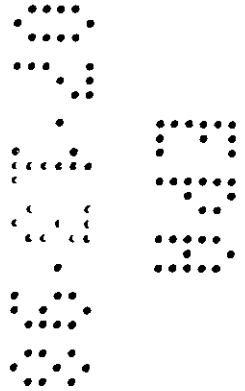

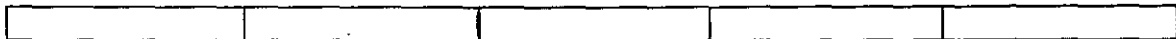

1. Remove one pre-filled applicator from package and hold in an upright position.
2. Open applicator by carefully cutting the top of the tube.
3. Position the tip of the applicator on the dog's back between the shoulder blades. Apply half of the contents of the tube.
4. Invert the applicator to an upright position and move to the dog's hind quarters. Position the tip of the applicator at the base of the tail and apply the remaining contents of the tube.
5. Do not reapply product for 30 days.

This product [or insert product name] is most effective when used as part of a total flea and tick management program. Use other Enforcer products registered for residential area control of these pests in conjunction with this treatment. For complete flea control, use ENFORCER<sup>®</sup> Flea Spray for Yards Concentrate and ENFORCER<sup>®</sup> Flea Spray for Homes.
