Dear Ms. Davis,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Because MRIDs 44858201-04 and MRIDs 44874701-08 related to <u>deltamethin</u>, these studies can not be cited to support your <u>permethin</u> based products.
- 2. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE, retain the "DO NOT USE ON CATS!" statement.

The Agency appreciates that spot-on flea and tick control products are popular among pet owners. However, due to the continued reports of incidents involving inadvertent exposure of cats to these products (either primarily through misuse or secondarily through interaction with a treated dog), we believe that further language and graphics should be added to existing and any future product labeling. For the above reasons, the Agency is considering the following labels changes to <u>all</u> product labeling of 45- 65% permethrin "spot-on" products:

- 3. On the front panel of the outside labeling, add 1) "Do Not Use on Cats" prominently displayed under the name of your product(s) and 2) an icon of a cat in a circle with a slash through it displayed on the front panel.
- 4. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE, add the following statement, "Cats which actively groom

or engage in close physical contact with recently treated dogs may be at risk of serious harmful effect."

- 5. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE, following DO NOT USE ON CATS, add the following statement, "May be toxic and potentially fatal if applied to or ingested by cats."
- 6. Include the statement "Do Not Use on Cats", on the small vials in addition to the outside cardboard container and/or the icon discussed under 1).

We are aware that your above noted labels already incorporates some of these items. Although the Agency is currently considering these label changes, you are under no obligation to incorporate these at this time. We anticipate that a letter requesting these voluntary changes will be sent to all registrants of the > 40% permethrin spot-on products in the near future. Because we are reviewing your labels at this time, we wanted to ensure that you were aware of developing issues which may impact these labels in the near future.

7. Regarding the confidential statement of formula (CSFs) for EPA Reg. No. 40849-72, in order to correct a deficiency noted in the August 18, 2000 review of your submission requested a new alternative formulations being made part of the record, you submitted amended CSFs on September 15, 2000. These CSFs are acceptable. The following CSFs are now the CSFs of record:

Basic Formulation Dated: September 15, 2000

Alternative Formulation Dated: 1B, September 15, 2000; 1C, June 12, 2000

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product [or product name] contains three monthly dosages, each 1 cc [2 cc]. This product [or product name] kills and repels fleas and ticks for up to 30 days. This product [or product name] kills and repels the Deer Tick which may carry Lyme Disease.

Graphics for Each Step

- 1. Remove one pre-filled applicator from package and hold in an upright position.
- 2. [Gently press cap to break the seal of the applicator.] Open applicator by carefully cutting the top of the tube.
- 3. [Carefully remove the cap.] Position the tip of the applicator on the dog's back between the shoulder blades. For small dogs (under 30 lbs.): Apply half of the contents of the tube (0.5 cc) and proceed with steps 4 and 5. For large dogs (over 30 lbs.): Apply the entire contents of the tube (1 cc) and proceed with steps 4 and 5.
- 4. For small dogs (under 30 lbs.): Invert the applicator to an upright position and move to the dog's hind quarters. Position the tip of the applicator at the base of the tail and apply the remaining contents of the tube (0.5 cc).
  - For large dogs (over 30 lbs.): Open another applicator (following directions provided in steps 1 and 2 above). Position the tip of the applicator at the base of the tail and apply the entire contents of the tube (1 cc).

Do not reapply product for 30 days.

Although this product [or product name] is applied only between the shoulder blades and at the base of the tail, the dog's skin and hair oils carry the product over the entire body for protection against fleas and ticks. Do not bathe the dog for 5 days before or 5 days after treatment. This product [or product name] is most effective when used as part of a total flea and tick management program. Use other Enforcer products registered for residential area control of these pests in conjunction with this treatment. For additional control of fleas in and around the home use Enforcer Flea Spray for Yards Concentrate and Enforcer Flea Spray for Homes.
