DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Scorcher Total Vegetation Killer concentrate will kill almost all vegetation down to the roots and prevent plant regrowth for up to one year. For use on gravel driveways, sidewalks, patios, along fence lines and curbs. DO NOT use on lawns, flower beds or vegetable gardens. Scorcher should NOT be applied over the root zones of trees or shrubs. See label diagram for root zone and drip line clarification.

DO NOT apply in sloped areas where runoff may adversely affect desirable plants.

For best results, if the soil is dry, water lightly before treatment. Apply Scorcher directly to weeds and grass. Thoroughly wet weeds but do not soak as runoff may occur.
