Dear Ms. Hawkes:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. The ingredient statement is generally required on the front panel. If the size or form of the package makes it impractical to place the ingredient statement on the front panel of the label, permission may be granted for the ingredient statement to appear elsewhere [40 CFR 156.10(g)(2)]. Your label indicates that the ingredient statement may appear on either the front or back panel, a change you made by notification on September 27, 1999. Such a change cannot be made by notification. Instead, you must submit a request to amend the label and include an explanation as to why it is not practical to place the ingredient statement on the front panel. Generally, EPA will not approve alternate placements of the ingredient statement to accommodate pictures, graphics or other marketing claims not required by FIFRA.
- 2. The statements near the beginning of the Directions for Use regarding the toxicity of this product to cats are complete and acceptable. Some of these statements (or modified versions of these statements) also appear in the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals section. The cat precautionary statements should be grouped together in one location. Accordingly, you should delete the following statements from the Hazards section: "Do not use on cats" and "Cats that actively groom or engage in close physical contact with recently treated dogs may be at risk of toxic exposure". If you would rather include the cat precautions in the Hazards section, you may do so, but the statements should appear
