The Registration Division (RD) has conducted its review of this request for its applicability under PRN 2007-4 and finds that the label change requested falls within the scope of PRN 2007-4. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on nonrefillable containers. The code may appear either on the label (and can be added by non-notification/PR Notice 98-10) or durably marked on the container itself.



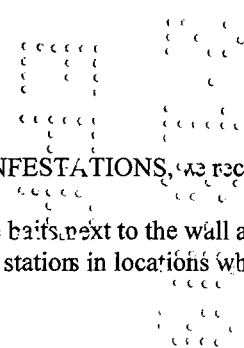

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Remove bait stations from container.
2. For thorough ant control, use all 6 baits at one time. For larger kitchens or **HEAVY INFESTATIONS**, we recommend using additional bait stations.
3. Baits work best on horizontal surfaces touching corners and walls. For example, place baits next to the wall along baseboards, in corners, under sinks, in cabinets and near plumbing fixtures. Place bait stations in locations where ants have been seen.



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4. Ants will begin eating the bait immediately. You will see fewer ants within days. Once the ants begin eating the bait, do not disturb the immediate area. Ants lay down a "scent trail" for other ants to follow. Disrupting this trail with cleaners or insecticides will eliminate the scent trail for the ants to follow.
5. Replace ALL baits every three months or until the ant population is completely eliminated.

For maximum effectiveness, replace baits before they are completely consumed.

NOTE: DO NOT apply aerosol insect sprays or pump sprays onto the surface areas to be treated with ant bait stations. Insecticide sprays will repel ants from feeding at bait stations locations

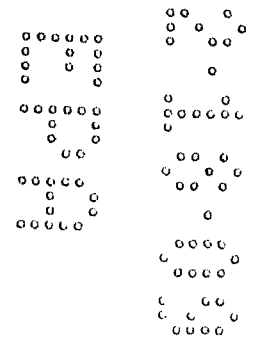

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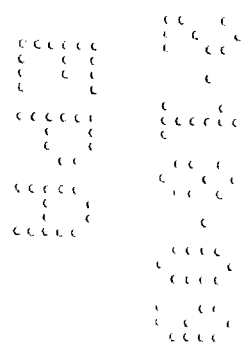
