C-SAN 18 FABRIC AND DIAPER SANITIZER is recommended for staining of ammonia causing bacteria in institutions. For laundering of fabrics and diapers.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Wet fabrics or diapers should be spin dried before sanitizer is applied. Four (4) oz. of C-SAN 18 FABRIC AND DIAPER SANITIZER should be added for each 16 gallon wash load. Run this solution in the pre-wash, followed by the regular wash cycle with a good detergent. The above application gives 200 ppm available chlorine in the pre-wash cycle.

The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after making. If the solution is allowed to stand or is reused and tests show the level of chlorine has not been maintained, additional C-SAN 18 FABRIC AND DIAPER SANITIZER should be added to give 200 ppm available chlorine in the pre-wash cycle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight or heat. In case of spill, food area with large quantities of water. Empty container thoroughly with water and its contents by placing in trash collection or approved landfill area. Do not use for food or feed storage, disposal or other equipment.
