Q=Max Swimmingpool Algaecide is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using O-Max Swimmingpool Algaecid

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 75 to 116 fluid ounces of Q-Max Swimmingpool Algae per 10,000 gal and of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of Q-Max Swimmingpool Algae 1d per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13.6 to 27 fluid ounces of Q-Max Swimmingpool Algae 1d per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of <u>8</u> to <u>12</u> fluid ounces of <u>0-Max Swimmingpool</u> Algae per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of <u>1</u> to <u>3</u> fluid ounces of <u>Q-Max Swimmingpool Algaecide</u> should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
