

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply I-DYNE DISINFECTANT with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Wetted surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the solution becomes visibly dirty.

I-DYNE DISINFECTANT is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-deodorizer in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil and 400 ppm hard water.

Disinfection—Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics, Other Health Care Institutions, Institutions, Industry, Schools, Farm Premises and Poultry Houses:

Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon I-DYNE DISINFECTANT to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, sinks and bedframes. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

For farms and poultry use, prior to disinfection, all poultry, other animals and their feeds must be removed from the premises. This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces occupied or traversed by poultry or other animals.

After disinfection, ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, or other animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

Sanitizing—Meat and food processing equipment and utensils: Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with 1 oz. per gallon of I-DYNE DISINFECTANT (or other good cleaner). Rinse with clean water and sanitize surfaces with 1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine). Surfaces should remain in contact with solution for 1-2 minutes. Drain well and air dry. No potable water rinse is required.

Hand Sanitizing—In food handling and meat curing operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Particulate Cooling Water—For canning operations—add 1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 5-10 gallons of return water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization—1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Shoe Bath Sanitizer—To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3-oz. per gallon solution of I-DYNE DISINFECTANT for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

DANGER
