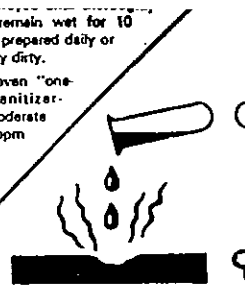

areas, a preliminary cleaning is re-
quired.

For farms and poultry use, prior to
disinfection, all poultry, other animals and
their feeds must be removed from the
premises. This includes emptying all troughs,
racks and other feeding and water appliances.
Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and
other surfaces occupied or traversed by poultry or other
animals.

After disinfection, ventilate buildings, coop and other
closed spaces. Do not house poultry, or other animals or
employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or
dried.

Sanitizing—Meat and food processing equipment and utensils:
Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with 1
oz. per gallon of I-DYNE DISINFECTANT for other good cleaned.
Rinse with clean water and sanitize surfaces with 1 oz. I-DYNE
DISINFECTANT per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine).
Surface should remain in contact with solution for 1-2 minutes. Drain
well and air dry. No potable water rinse is required.
