Applications should be made to the water supply to remove scale, algae, and other deposits. An initial dose of 100 ppm of El-Kleen per 1000 gallons of water is recommended for initial control. See label.

Subsequent slug additions should be made at 100 ppm of El-Kleen per 1000 gallons of water should be made weekly. The frequency of additional slug additions should be determined by bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made on the same day of the week.

El-Kleen is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 3.3 to 6.6 fluid ounces of El-Kleen per 1000 gallons of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosing until control is evident.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.1 to 6.6 fluid ounces of El-Kleen per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
