INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

For control of algae growth in swimming pools in a manner safe to man and pool.

SACONAVICIDE is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using CSCO SWIM-CIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 1/2 to 1/4 fluid ounces of CSCO SWIM-CIDE per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 1/4 to 1/2 fluid ounces of CSCO SWIM-CIDE per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth subsequent additions of 9 to 18 fluid ounces of CSCO-SWIM-CIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 6 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

CSCO SWIM CIDE is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. CSCO SWIM CIDE can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However do not mix CSCO SWIM CIDE with concentrated hydrochloric acid or chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of container in an incinerator or in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place. Rinseate that cannot be used or processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.
