LAUNDRING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE OR AUTOMATIC WASHER:
IN SOAKING SUDS—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each
gal of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry 11 min. to overnight.
Wash. Rinse.

IN WASHING SUDS—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each
gal water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse. (For
automatic washers into which laundry is placed before water is added, dilute
recommended amount of this sodium hypochlorite solution in qt. of water and pour
into washer after laundry is immersed.)

BLEACH, DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER OR CLEANSER:
To remove **STAINS**—Fruit, Berry, Wine, Coffee, Tea, Chocolate, Vegetable, Flower,
Grass, Blood and many Ink, Dye and Medicine Stains, also **SCORCH** and **MILDEW** (Do
not use on silk, wool or unfast colors). Make solution 2 tablespoons of this sodium
hypochlorite solution for each qt. cold water. Mix thoroughly. Immerse fabric 5 to 15

FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES AND SILVERWARE:
Immerse for 30 seconds in solution of 2 ozs. of this sodium hypochlorite solution to 4
gallons of water in final rinse tank of dishwashing procedures. This product may be
employed in hot or cold water.

Eating and drinking utensils properly washed and submerged in product solutions,
prepared as directed, will be sanitized in accordance with health department
requirements.

Basic measurements: 4 tbsps., or 2 ozs. of this sodium hypochlorite solution added to
four gallons of water equals 200 ppm available chlorine solution. 8 ozs. equals one cup
or one-half pint.

NOTE: This product reacts with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage,
as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away
from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse
empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard.
If by placing in trash collection or burying in approved landfill. Product or rinsate, if
cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do

IN WASHING SUDS—Add 1 tablet to 1 gallon of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent to automatic washers into which the recommended amount of this solution is added. Wash. Rinse.

BLEACH, DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT: To remove STAINS—Fruit, Berry, Grass, Blood and many Ink, Dye and other stains. Do not use on silk, wool or unfastened fabrics. Add 1/2 tablet per gallon of water. Rinse well in clear water. Residue usually disappears when fabric is dried.

FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES, CUTLERY, ETC.: Immerse for 30 seconds in solution of 1/2 tablet per gallon of water in final rinse. Use in hot or cold water.

Eating and drinking utensils properly prepared as directed, will be safe for use.

Basic measurements 4 lbs. per 200 lbs. of water equals 200 parts per million or one-half pint.

NOTE: This product requires water to be used to obtain the desired effect.
