HOW TO APPLY

For green, blue-green and filamentous algae: Appl. evenly over the filamentous algae for full but light coverage. If the area is heavily infested use the heavier mixing instructions. Treat from the shorelines out to prevent trapping fish. To prevent oxygen depletion below fish sustaining levels, treat no more than 1/3 to 1/2 of the lake per application. Allow sufficient time between treatments for oxygen levels to recover. Algae is controlled most effectively under bright sunny conditions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS — Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL — Pesticide, spraying mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically re-processed should be disposed of according to procedures approved by federal, state and local authorities.
