Under First Aid statement, If swallowed, delete "Give at least 1 ounce of milk of magnesia or aluminum hydroxide gel in an equal amount of water. If these are not available, give milk, white of 2 or 3 eggs or gelatin solution."

2. Add the following headings: "Precautionary Statements:" Directly under this heading place "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals. Place the word "Danger"...directly in front of the word "Corrosive". Delete the word "May" from "May cause chemical burns." Add the statement "Avoid breathing dust, irritating to nose and throat." Move the statement "Do not get in eyes, etc." see enclosed label, to under the Hazards statements.

Add "Physical and Chemical Hazards" heading over the "Strong Oxidizing Agent" statement. Add "Do not mix with organic matter, mix only in clean, dry utensils."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
