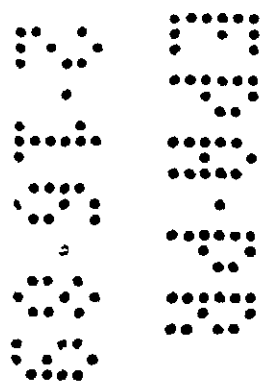

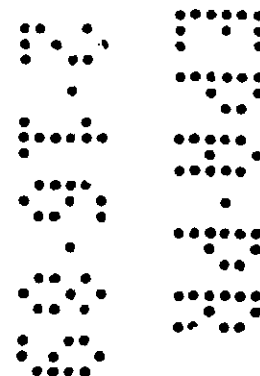
**Precautionary Statements
