Hand feed at the rate of 0.33 oz. of Golden Rabon 200 Mineral per 100 lbs. of body weight to provide 70 mg. Rabon per 100 lbs. body weight. Rabon 200 should be fed free choice while cattle are grazing. Cattle weighing 600 lbs. should consume 2 oz. of Rabon 200. Place in a feeder away from the water to control grazing patterns of the pasture.
