Sunshine Algaeicide Formula A is compatible with most chemicals used in pool water and will not damage tile, concrete, metal or plastics. Continued usage as directed will keep pool water sparkling clear and free of visible green algae, blue green algae and slime. It improves filter operation and cuts down the need for other chemicals.

Sunshine Algaeicide Formula A imparts tone and a pleasant "feel" to swimming pool water. Sunshine Algaeicide Formula A is stable. It may be stored for prolonged periods of time without losing strength or effectiveness.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
- Open dumping is prohibited.

#### CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place. Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**INITIAL DOSE:** One (1) gallon Algaeicide for each 25,000 gallons of water or 16 oz. (2 cups) for each 3,000 gallons of water. Apply to freshly filled, clean pools.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** One (1) quart for each 25,000 gallons of water every 2 days in warm, sunny or humid weather, or if pool has unusually heavy use. Every 3 to 5 days in cool or cloudy weather.

**BOOSTER DOSE:** Add one (1) quart for each 25,000 gallons of water or 4 oz. for each 3,000 gallons of water after a heavy or prolonged rainfall.

When swimming season is over add one (1) gallon for each 25,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This does help provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

**IMPORTANT:** Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

Sunshine Algaeicide Formula A requires no special equipment for applications. It may be poured directly into the water from any point around the pool or through any water circulating system. Wait 10 to 15 minutes before entering pool.


