

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Include the heading "Directions For Use" and add the misuse statement directly beneath to read:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 - b. Delete the entire Phenol Coefficients claim.
 - c. Include the heading "Storage and Disposal" and subheading: Pesticide Disposal and Container Disposal. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for guidance.
 - d. Delete all reference to A.F. Schultz Company.
 - e. Revise the precautionary statement to read:

Precautionary Statements

Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals

Corrosive: Causes severe eye and skin damage.
Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

- f. The statement "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" goes directly above the signal word "Caution" (center panel only).
- g. Delete all sanitization claims on the label.
- h. Indicate "how the product is to be applied" (mop, wipe, spray, etc.).
- i. Include a "Statement of Practical Treatment."
- j. Include a Note to Physician statement to read:

Note to Physician

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.


- k. Delete the phrase "Non-irritating in use dilution" and the words "Air Dry."
 - l. Delete the statement "Includes 8 1/2% alkylated"
 - m. Revise the statement "EPA No." to "EPA Registration No."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

LIQUICOM

1. For sanitation of glass, bottles, etc.
Hard Surfaces. Clean with a sanitizing wash made with 1 1/4 liquid oz. of LIQUICOM and 2 gals. water. AIR DRY. DO NOT USE TOWEL.

2. General disinfection of inanimate objects: hospital wards, sick-rooms, operation rooms, refrigerators, lavatories, floors, etc. Add 2 1/2 oz. Liquicom to 1 gallon of water (800 p.p.m.) to previously cleaned surfaces. Add 3 1/4 oz. to 1 gallon (1000 p.p.m.) for porous surfaces and surfaces difficult to clean.

3. For general sanitation and disinfecting. Clean with LIQUICOM as in part 1. Rinse thoroughly, then immerse in LIQUICOM diluted 1 1/4 oz. to 2 gals. of water.

The disinfectant at the same dilution is also recommended as a flank and udder sanitizer prior to milking.

Rinse thoroughly with potable water before milking.
