The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete the company name "Camp Industrial Division" from your labels. According to our records, this product was transferred to "Sunshine Chemical Corporation" in 1985.
 - b. Include the heading "Directions For Use" and add the misuse statement directly below it to read:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 - c. Include the heading "Storage and Disposal" and the subheadings: Pesticide Disposal and Container Disposal. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for guidance.
 - d. Change "cross-infection" to "cross-contamination."
 - e. Delete all sanitization claims as per your letter of December 8, 1987.



DIRECTIONS:

FOR DISINFECTING: Use 2 ounces DEGERM PLUS DISINFECTANT DETERGENT per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* at this level. This has been substantiated by the A/CAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, it is also effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*. For best results, use DEGERM PLUS DISINFECTANT DETERGENT with a brush or mop and apply to floors, bathroom tile, tubs, sinks, locker rooms.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a preliminary scrubbing is required. SP-1 ALL PURPOSE CLEANER IS RECOMMENDED. Rinse empty containers thoroughly with water.

DANGER

Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes or skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:
