

- i. Include a comma between the two words "Germicidal cleaner" (center panel only).

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

An effective disinfectant cleaner and deodorant for hospitals, homes, motels, hotels, schools, nursing homes, nurseries, factories, business and industrial buildings, restaurants, food plants, boats, campers and automobile and airplane interiors.

Cleans and deodorizes porcelain, tiling, grouting, stainless steel, enameled surfaces, woodwork, formica, leather, vinyl, and plastic.

1. Cleaning and Deodorizing: Hold sprayer nozzle 6 to 8 inches from the surface to be cleaned. Thoroughly wet the area. Allow the solution to penetrate for about one minute and then wipe away the soil with a clean cloth or sponge. The wiping cloth may be predampened with water or with this product.

- 2. For Disinfection:** Before the surface as in Step 1. Use enough fresh solution to cover the surface. Allow the disinfectant to remain on the surfaces for 10 minutes after the treatment from the start.
- 3. For Mildew:** Follow directions on label. Repeat treatment every time growth first reappears.
