Allow the product to dissolve completely. 5. Retest the chlorine level. 6. Repeat steps 2-5 until the chlorine level is at the desired level. 7. Maintain the chlorine level at the desired level. 8. Retest the chlorine level every 2-3 days. 9. Repeat steps 2-5 as needed. 10. Do not use the pool until the chlorine level is at the desired level.

**DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE WATER
FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS**

1. Determine the size of the water system in gallons. 2. Determine the current chlorine level in the water. 3. Add the appropriate amount of product to the water. 4. Allow the product to dissolve completely. 5. Retest the chlorine level. 6. Repeat steps 2-5 until the chlorine level is at the desired level. 7. Maintain the chlorine level at the desired level. 8. Retest the chlorine level every 2-3 days. 9. Repeat steps 2-5 as needed. 10. Do not use the water until the chlorine level is at the desired level.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT

1. Determine the size of the equipment in gallons. 2. Determine the current chlorine level in the equipment. 3. Add the appropriate amount of product to the equipment. 4. Allow the product to dissolve completely. 5. Retest the chlorine level. 6. Repeat steps 2-5 until the chlorine level is at the desired level. 7. Maintain the chlorine level at the desired level. 8. Retest the chlorine level every 2-3 days. 9. Repeat steps 2-5 as needed. 10. Do not use the equipment until the chlorine level is at the desired level.
