This ADS Dish Machine is adjusted to deliver 100 parts per million available chlorine for the final sanitizing rinse (7.68cc's to the gallon of water, to be determined by using the chlorine test kit). Sanitizer is to be used only in connection with A.D.S. commercial dishwashing system which is developed to wash and sanitize institutional dishware. This product is not for sale or to be used for any other purpose other than in connection with the A.D.S. commercial Dish Machine units.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or rinsate that cannot be used should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
