This Burns Dish Machine Sanitizer is available in 68cc's per gallon of water (7.68cc's to the gallon) of water using the chlorine test kit. It is used in connection with Burns Dish Machine Sanitizer system which is developed for institutional dish ware. This sanitizer should not be used for any other purpose than with the Burns commercial dish machine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store away from direct sunlight. In large quantities of water, dilute thoroughly with water and discard by placing in trash landfill. Product or rinsate should be diluted with water and disposed. Do not contaminate waterways. Dispose or cleaning of equipment.
