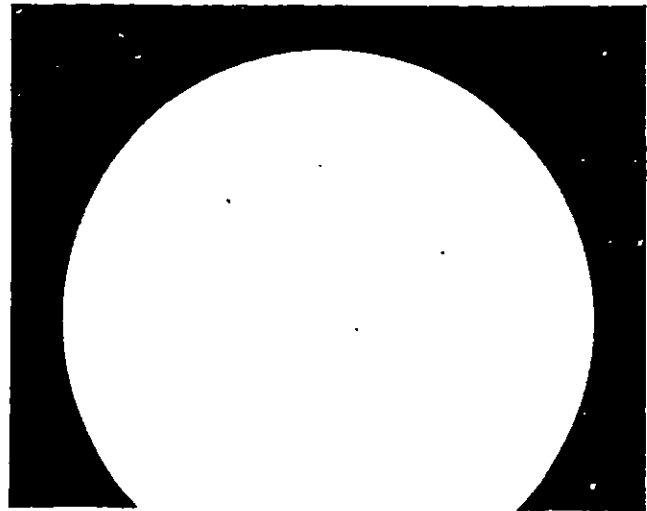

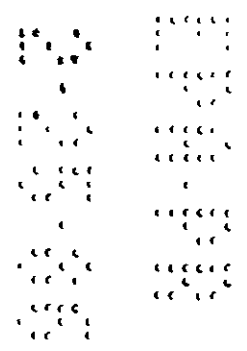

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Prior to use clean pools or tanks containing heavy algae growth.

- 1. Turn off the filter or circulating pump.
- 2. Place the pill in the pump strainer basket.
- 3. Turn the pump back on.
- 4. Keep the pump in operation during treatment. It may take a few hours for the algaecide completely to dispense.
- 5. Remove the pill when the algaecide is gone and dispose of it as directed. Replace it with another, as necessary.

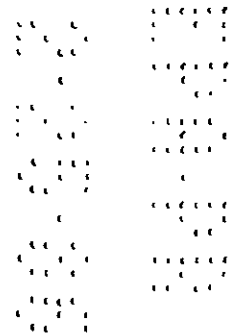
**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store Aquapill 8 Algaecide in a safe, dry place.

Securely wrap the used Aquapill 8 Algaecide in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Do not discard water treated with Aquapill 8 Algaecide in gardens, or on lawns or ornamental plants.
