For a 30,000 gallon pool, use 1 1/2 ounces. For a 40,000 gallon pool, use 2 ounces. For a 50,000 gallon pool, use 2 1/2 ounces. For a 60,000 gallon pool, use 3 ounces. For a 70,000 gallon pool, use 3 1/2 ounces. For a 80,000 gallon pool, use 4 ounces. For a 90,000 gallon pool, use 4 1/2 ounces. For a 100,000 gallon pool, use 5 ounces. For a 110,000 gallon pool, use 5 1/2 ounces. For a 120,000 gallon pool, use 6 ounces. For a 130,000 gallon pool, use 6 1/2 ounces. For a 140,000 gallon pool, use 7 ounces.
