to the tips of the hair. To control stable flies  
and horse flies, apply 2 ounces per adult animal  
hair, but not to soak the hide. Repeat  
twice daily or at intervals necessary for  
protection.

To control blood-sucking lice, apply to  
infested areas, using a stiff brush to get  
into the tips of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per  
square foot of area. Repeat every two or three weeks as required.

To control insects in kennels and animal  
quarters, before treating area and ventilate thoroughly  
to prevent insects from re-entering treated area.

For rapid cleanout of fleas and ticks  
in animal quarters apply this product in a good  
thorough manner. Apply to the pet's  
hair in a fine mist. Pay special attention to cracks and crevice  
places. Bedding should be removed and  
replaced.

To control flies, mosquitoes and gnats  
in animal quarters, apply this product in a good  
thorough manner. Use at the rate of  
one ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Fill the  
mist wherever practical. Keep doors and windows  
closed for 15 minutes or more after application. Do  
not spray directly on animals. Ventilate after treatment is  
complete.
