Repeat at 5 to 10 min. ute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2 PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine, DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. Parathion is a strong cholmesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edma, the patient should be given supple mental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and fatal relapses have been reported after initial improve ment, VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS
