HOT TUB ALGAECIDE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this
product in a manner inconsistent with its la-
beling.

HOT TUB ALGAECIDE is used to control
the growth of algae in exterior hot tubs. For
maximum effectiveness, Hot Tubs containing
heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior
to using **HOT TUB ALGAECIDE**.

For hot tubs having just visible algae growth
add an initial dose of 10 to 15 fluid ounces
of **HOT TUB ALGAECIDE** per 1,000 gallons.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled
hot tub, add initially 7 to 10 fluid ounces of
HOT TUB ALGAECIDE per 1,000 gallons.

To maintain hot tubs free of visible algae
growth, subsequent additions of 3 to 5 fluid
ounces of **HOT TUB ALGAECIDE** should be
made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treat-
ment.

HOT TUB ALGAECIDE is compatible with
those chemicals normally used to treat hot
tubs and effective at both acid and alkaline
pH. **HOT TUB ALGAECIDE** can be used in hot
tubs treated with chlorine chemicals and may
reduce the amount of those chemicals nor-
mally required. However, do not mix **HOT TUB
ALGAECIDE** with concentrated dry or liquid
chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container
closed when not in use. Do not contaminate
water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or
cleaning of equipment. The container must be
triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for
recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an
approved landfill or buried in a safe place.
Residue that cannot be used or reprocessed
should be disposed of in a landfill approved
for pesticides or buried in a safe place away
from water supplies. Open dumping is prohi-
bited.
