For hot tubs having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 10 to 15 fluid ounces of HOT TUB ALGAECIDE per 1,000 gallons.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled hot tub, add initially 7 to 10 fluid ounces of HOT TUB ALGAECIDE per 1,000 gallons.

To maintain hot tubs free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 3 to 5 fluid ounces of HOT TUB ALGAECIDE should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment
