Used according to directions KIC-OUT kills bacteria, controls algae, and destroys organic waste. Add KIC-OUT at the rate of 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water. Add total amount at one time, broadcasting directly into pool water. Add KIC-OUT at night or when pool is not in use. There will be an initial high chlorine reading and the pool should not be placed in use until the residual available chlorine is at a normal level of 1.0 to 3.0 ppm as determined by a test kit. Use KIC-OUT once weekly for heavily used commercial or semi-commercial pools and once every two weeks for residential pools receiving normal usage.

Between treatments with KIC-OUT to remove organic wastes, use your normal chlorine source to maintain the residual chlorine concentration of the pool water between 1.0 and 3.0 ppm as determined by a test kit. Follow directions on label for specific product used for this purpose.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.
