

#### DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Scrape and preflush food soil from tableware and glasses.
2. Wash in detergent solution.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in solution of 1 oz. sanitizer to 2 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm active sanitizer. Check solution with short range pH papers (3.0-5.5 pH). 200 ppm active sanitizer = 4.5 pH. Immerse all tableware for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by local regulations.
5. Place sanitized tableware on a clean sanitized surface to air dry.

Note: Do not use in galvanized sinks.

#### PRODUCT INFORMATION

This product is an odorless, acid type sanitizer which is ideal for glassware, dishes, pots, pans, utensils and kitchen equipment. It softens water to reduce hard water mineral deposits and eliminate filming. Can also be used for removing mineral deposits from drinking fountains, sinks, tea kettles, coffee pots, drain boards and from glass, plastic and stainless steel utensils and equipment.
