gallon of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool,
50 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 15NF per 10,000

gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the
pool has been cleaned.

ALGAECIDE 15NF is compatible with those
used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alk-
aline pH. ALGAECIDE 15NF can be used in pools treated with chlorine.
Do not mix ALGAECIDE 15NF with concentrated
chlorine products.

ALGAECIDE 15NF is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools should be free of any growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using ALGAECIDE 15NF.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 50 to 77 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 15NF per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 77 to 50 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 15NF per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 9 to 18 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 15NF per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

ALGAECIDE 15NF is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. ALGAECIDE 15NF can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix ALGAECIDE 15NF with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of container by an incinerator or in an approved landfill, or bury in a safe place. Rinse that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open flame is prohibited.
