

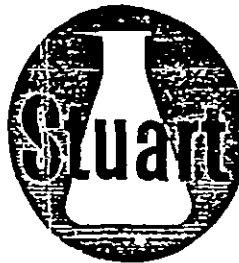
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

DASCO ADDITIVE B-2830 is used to inhibit bacterial and fungal degradation of water-based and water-soluble or emulsifiable cutting fluids and coolants used in metalworking operations. It should be added to the diluted cutting fluid at a rate that will provide 150 to 250 parts per million DASCO ADDITIVE B-2830 after final dilution with water (15.25 to 25.4 fl. oz. per 1000 gal. of diluted solution). To prevent fungal growth on the inside walls of the diluted metalworking fluid storage tanks, higher concentrations of DASCO ADDITIVE B-2830 are needed. For this application, it is recommended that DASCO ADDITIVE B-2830 be added to the diluted fluid as it is prepared to provide a concentration of 1000 to 1250 parts per million (117 to 145 fl. oz. per 1000 gal. of diluted solution).

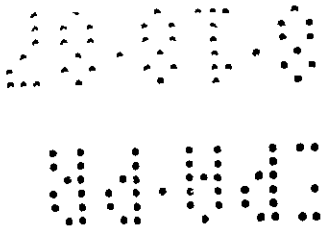
