Designed for use in Restaurants, Food Storage Warehouses, Flour Mills, Meat Packing Plants, Farms, Dairy Barns and the like. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL — Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse that cannot be used should be disposed of according to procedures approved by Federal, State or Local disposal authorities.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL — Under 30 gallon sizes : Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place. 30 gallon sizes and over. a) reseal containers and offer for reconditioning or b) triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

"FOG-20" CONCENTRATE contains pyrethrum and piperonyl butoxide. This combination produces a fog or spray with rapid knockdown and high mortalities to insects.

For Fogging: Use approximately 1 ounce of "FOG-20" CONCENTRATE for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. For the control of flies, mosquitoes, gnats and spiders. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Keep doors and windows closed for at least 10 minutes. Sweep up and destroy all fallen insects. Follow recommendations of equipment manufacturer for proper positioning of the fogging machine.

FOR SPRAYING:

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats: Close doors and windows. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Direct the spray toward the ceiling. Allow room to remain closed for at least 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up all dead insects and destroy them. Repeat treatment when necessary. Frequent spraying of breeding places also helps.
Fog-20 can also be used to eliminate fleas, roaches, waterbugs, carpet beetles and ants.
