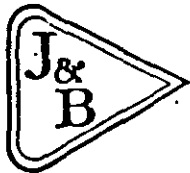

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### ON ANIMALS:

To protect animals from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Apply a light mist sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, apply 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair, but not to soak the hide. Repeat treatment once or twice daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood-sucking lice: Apply the spray lightly to indicated areas, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per animal. Repeat every two or three weeks as required.

### DARKS, MILK ROOMS, DAIRY PLANTS:

To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats: Apply as a fog or fine mist, directing the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the room until the area is filled with mist, using about 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, close windows and doors before spraying and keep closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Vacate the area and ventilate before re-occupying. Repeat application as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with food and foodstuffs. To avoid contamination, remove or cover clothing during processing. Surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned during treatment or thoroughly washed before using. When using in areas, apply only when necessary and in accordance with directions.
