

- e. Change "See back panel for additional precautions" to "See left panel, etc."

- f. Change "May be harmful if swallowed, etc." to May be fatal if swallowed, etc."
- g. Add to Environmental Hazards "Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of waste."

#### Notes:

Field Corn, Sweet Corn: Mix 3.6 ounces per 100 pounds of seed (2 ounces per bushel) as a dry mixture in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting.

Mixing Instructions: For best results, fill planter box only half full of seed, add half the required amount of Diazinon®-Lindane-Captan Seed Treater and mix thoroughly with a stick or paddle. Add the remainder of the seed and Diazinon®-Lindane-Captan Seed Treater and mix again so that all seeds are covered. DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.

Important: Treated Seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time.
