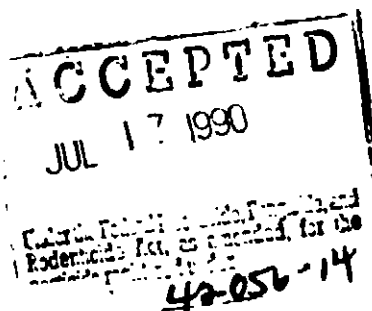

RATE: Sorghum: Use at a rate of one pouch per 30 lbs. of seed (3 ounces per bushel). Apply as a dry mixture in the planter or drill box as a seed treatment prior to planting.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: For best results, fill planter or drill box only half full of seed, add half the required amount of Captan-Lindane Seed Treatment and mix thoroughly with a stick or paddle. Add the remainder of the seed and Captan-Line Seed Treatment and mix again so that all seeds are covered. **DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.**

PRODUCT INFORMATION

TCI Captan-Lindane Seed Treatment is a specially formulated combination of lindane for protection against wireworms and captan for protection against fungus diseases of seeds and seedlings.

NOTE: Adjust the seed drill or planter to give the required rate of seed delivery with treated seed. Regularly inspect the seeding mechanism and clean as required.

IMPORTANT: Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed or processed for oil. Treat only those seed needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Store in cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat.
