DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Also protects seeds and seedling from wireworm damage. TCI Mancozeb-Lindane seed treatment is formulated with graphite to lubricate the planter and assure a smooth even flow in the furrow.

Rate:

Wheat, Oats, Barley, Rye.....Use 2 ounces per bushel of seed. Corn, Sorghum..................Use 3 ounces per bushel of seed.

NOTE: One level scoop (enclosed) is equivalent to approximately one avoirdupois ounce of this product.

Apply as a drill-box or planter-box treatment. For best results, fill planter box or drill only half full of seed, add half the required amount of Mancozeb-Lindane Seed Treatment and mix thoroughly with a stick or paddle. Add the remainder of the seed and product and mix again so that all seeds are covered. DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.
