

TCI Mancozeb Ready-to-Use Seed Treatment is a formulation designed for the treatment of wheat, oats, barley and rye in the drill-box at planting time. It will control bunt of wheat and rye, covered smuts of oats and barley, and damping-off, seed rot and seedling blights on all labeled crops.

DIRECTIONS - TCI Mancozeb Ready-to-Use Seed Treatment is formulated for application as a pour-on drill box application or in an on-farm seed treatment machine. This product does not require the addition of water for application.

RATE - Wheat, oats, barley, rye, - Use 4 fluid ounces per bushel of seed.

Hopper or Drill-box application: Mix well before use. For best results fill planter box or drill only half full of seed, add one half the required amount of TCI Mancozeb Ready-to-Use Seed Treatment and mix thoroughly with a stick or paddle. Add the remainder of the seed and product and mix again so that all seeds are covered. DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.

On-Farm Seed Treatment Machine Application: Add a measured amount of seed to the machine hopper. Apply TCI Mancozeb Ready-to-Use Seed Treatment by pouring on top of the seed. Mix thoroughly until all seeds are uniformly covered.


