Directions For Use

Vitavax-Thiram-Metalaxyl seed treatment is a ready-to-use product. Apply as a pour-on hopper-box application or through on-farm seed treatment equipment. Vitavax-Thiram-Metalaxyl seed treatment combines the systemic action of carboxin and metalaxyl with the surface action of thiram to control certain seed rot/seedling blight diseases including *Pythium*, *Rhizoctonia*, *Fusarium* and *Helminthosporium*. Vitavax-Thiram-Metalaxyl seed treatment also contains molybdenum as an aid in the nitrogen fixation process of the soybean plant. Fill planter box or mixing vessel with seed, pour the required amount of Vitavax-Thiram-Metalaxyl seed treatment evenly on top of seed. Stir thoroughly with a stick or paddle so that all seeds are covered.

Rates

Soybeans: Use 4.0 fl. oz. of Vitavax-Thiram-Metalaxyl seed treatment per bushel of seed (6.7 fl. oz. per 100 lbs of seed). On soybeans, do not graze or feed livestock on forage and hay on treated areas.

Use Restrictions

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seed needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seed beyond planting time. Note: Regularly inspect planter plates and mechanisms and clean as required for proper seeding. At the end of each day of use, clean out the electric eye monitors according to the manufacturer's directions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty containers.

Storage: Store in a cool dry location. Do not store at temperatures below 32°F.
