DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is designed for the rapid control of algae and for superchlorination at time of pool opening. These quick dissolving granules will destroy most strains of unsightly algae within 24 hours. Dead algae will come to rest on the pool floor. Remove by vacuuming frequently.

POOL OPENING:

For new pool or spring start up, superchlorinate with 10 to 20 ounces for each 10,000 gallons of water to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chlorine by weight. Check the level of available chlorine with a test kit. Adjust and maintain pool water pH to between 7.2 to 7.6. Adjust and maintain the alkalinity between 50 to 100 ppm.

TREATMENT OF ALGAE GROWTH:

For Visible Algae Growth - Superchlorinate the pool with 10 to 20 ounces of product for each 10,000 gallons of water to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chlorine by weight. Check the level of available chlorine with a test kit.

NOTE: Re-entry into treated swimming pool is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm of chlorine.

Vinyl Pools – Pre dissolve product in a plastic bucket. Stir. Let insoluble matter settle to the bottom of the bucket. Pour liquid solution into deep end of pool. If algae persists, repeat treatment. **To control algae growth** – Superchlorinate every 7 days by adding 10 ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.
