GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior heated pools, whirlpools and hot baths. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 18 to 27 fluid ounces of Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X per 10 000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 10 to 18 fluid ounces of Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X per 10 000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 3.5 to 7 fluid ounces of Olympic Concentrated Algicide 40X per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However do not mix Olympic Concentrated Algaecide 40X with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of container in an incinerator or in an approved landfill, or bury in a safe place. Rinseate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides, or buried in a safe place, away from water supply. Open dumping is prohibited.
