Concentrated Algaecide 40X is used to control algae in pools, exterior heated pools, whirlpools, and hot tubs. It is most effective in pools containing heavy growth of algae. Concentrated Algaecide 40X is used to control algae in pools.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add 1 ounce of Concentrated Algaecide 40X per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools with settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools, add 1 ounce of Concentrated Algaecide 40X per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, add 1 fluid ounce of Concentrated Algaecide 40X per 10,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Concentrated Algaecide 40X is compatible with other pool chemicals and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Concentrated Algaecide 40X can be used in pools treated with chlorine. Amount of those chemicals normally required should be added. Algaecide 40X with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine.

STORAGE AND

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store in areas where it can be fed by storage, disposal or cleaning. Containers used or reprocessed should be disposed of properly. Open dumping is prohibited. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of in a clear water.

METAL CONTAINERS: Triple rinse and dispose of in approved landfill area.
